The cost of camp is \$265 per camper. A \$25 nonrefundable deposit must accompany each registration. This will leave a balance of \$240 due on the first day of camp. Limited scholarships are available. Registrations should be postmarked no later than May 31. After May 31 the cost of camp will be \$295.
